**Speaker: Dr. Prasannar Jayakar, M.B.B.S., MD, PhD.**

Dr. Jayakar is the founding Chairman of the Miami Children's Hospital Brain Institute and the Director of the Neuroscience Center. After completing medical school in Bombay, India; he did a Ph.D. in neurophysiology and bioengineering at the university of Manitoba, Canada and fellowship at the Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard University. Dr Jayakar's research interests include the development and integration of neurophysiology and imaging technologies including invasive EEG recordings and functional mapping of critical areas to enhance the surgical management of intractable epilepsy. He has received external research grants exceeding 7million dollars, published over 80 scientific peer reviewed publications, 18 book chapters, and lectures extensively and serve on several national committees, journal editorial board and as examiner for national boards.
